This letter is to inform you of the events that are being held this term and information for the January re-sit BTEC exams.

Parent Review Day – Thursday 21st November 9-6pm

If you have not yet booked an appointment or would like a phone call from tutors then please book this with reception on 0151 319 4120. All students have an independent study day apart from the level 2 NVQ Activity Leadership who are required in from 9-3pm at Vauxhall on this day. The NVQ students have their first examiner visit on Friday 22nd November from NCFE. This is to verify the work that they have completed to date and to check progress against the qualification. It is vitally important that students attend the Thursday session in order to complete any outstanding work.

Challenger USA – Monday 25th November

We welcome Challenger USA next Monday 25th November to deliver a work experience presentation to our Year 13 and Foundation Degree students about opportunities for this summer around America. They will visit both our Spellow Lane and Jericho sites. Any students who are 18 prior to Easter are also eligible to access this opportunity and are welcome at this presentation.

Brook Organisation – Friday 29th November

On Friday 29th November all students at **Vauxhall** will receive education and training from Brook Organisation regarding topics such as healthy relationships and sex education, online safety, self-esteem and confidence, equality and diversity. Each group will take part in a carousel of workshops. It is a compulsory aspect of post sixteen education so that all our students are well informed about the choices and decisions that may affect them in life.
