Please find below some events that are happening this spring term (up to Easter) involving some or all of our students. Please note that there are only 10 college weeks until the start of exam season. In addition students are to complete their coursework units by the June deadline.

Thursday 23rd January	Coaching experience Aruba Our students had a brilliant time coaching in Aruba with some excellent feedback gained from all the teams and schools coached 3 of our foundation degree students have been recommended for a summer of additional work experience on the island from June to September! What an opportunity for them to enhance their skills and experience.
Commencing 24th/25th February (Each Monday & Tuesday)	Twilight football training for Everton College will commence at Heron Eccles Playing Fields 5.30-7pm for all current students. This is a voluntary session. If you would like to attend please see David James or James Croxton.
Thursday/Friday 27th & 28th February	World Record Challenge Students from across all sites, in particular Jericho and Vauxhall will be involved in our World Record Challenge for a 72 Hour Football session. This finishes at half time Goodison at the Everton match. This means that there are NO FORMAL LESSONS taking place at Jericho or Vauxhall sites on these days as those students will be involved in this challenge. Friday 6th March	External Examiner – Level 2 OCR Spellow The external examiner is visiting to ensure that our students are completing all necessary work to pass their qualification. 4 units will have been completed prior to the visit. Students are aware of this and understand that they may have to attend extra sessions in order to complete all work. This may also involve a small number of the students meeting the examiner to discuss their work to date.
Wednesday 18th March	BTEC Year 13 January exam results are available
Monday 23rd March	Valencia work experience meeting and workshop Our work experience project to Valencia is straight after the Easter break. This session is to prepare students for this and complete all necessary administration for the trip. Parents will be invited into college for a meeting next term - date to be confirmed. This trip involves 20 students who will be coaching and playing football as well as experiencing the culture of Valencia. Students involved have been sent home this week with information from our partner company Everything is Possible and a letter will be sent out once flights have been confirmed. <i>Could I please ask the parents/guardians of those involved to ensure that a European Health Care Card is applied for on line and that a copy of this is given to a member of college staff.</i>
Sunday 29th March 2 weeks	Students will be taking part in the Dallas Cup firstly flying to Florida to take part in football events then onto Austin Dallas to play in this event. This involves most students studying at Vauxhall and Jericho Lane.
