



Everton Football College statement - 16-19 Tuition Fund from September 2020

The Department of Education announced funding to support students whose learning was disrupted because of the COVID pandemic. This additional funding is available to all 16 to 19 providers and is targeted to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. The guidance indicates that the supported students must be on a 16 to 19 study programme and used for those who have not achieved grade 5 or above in GCSE maths and/or English by age 16. The subjects covered in the tuition will not be limited to English and maths but will also be used to support vocational learning and study support where necessary.

Support is being prioritised where students will benefit most from small group tuition, and particular regard is being given to the requirements of disadvantaged students and students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND).

We have committed to using the Tuition Fund in the following ways:

- Additional sessions will be limited to no more than 5 students and will take place in addition to the normal planned timetabled hours
- GCSE resit preparation
- Functional skills assessment preparation where required.
- Support for SEND and High Needs Students
- Vocational catch-up sessions for knowledge and practical skills development
- 1-1 study support where needed in all subjects
- Investment in VLE resources and Online programmes

- producing this statement setting out how the fund will be used to support the most disadvantaged students.
- publishing this statement on the College website.
